During 2020, 147,918 work injury and illness cases were reported to the Pennsylvania Bureau of Workers' Compensation<sup>\*</sup>. The 2020 total is 24,838 less than the number reported in 2019, undoubtedly due to COVID-19 government and business related shutdowns. However, some local counties, such as Lebanon, York, Perry, Juniata, and Northumberland saw increases in workers' compensation claims.
